**PROCEDURES**

No entry fee required. Open to all 9th – 12th grade students attending school in Bosque County as well as students from Hamilton, Hico, McGregor, Whitney High Schools and Home Schools.

Media Categories include: 1. Watercolor/Tempera; 2. Oil/Acrylic; 3. Pastel; 4. Drawing-Pencil/Ink/Charcoal (color and graphite); 5. Mixed Media.\* [\*Mixed Media is defined as including one or more of the other 4 categories. For example, colored pencil and watercolor or ink and acrylic.]

We accept only original art which does NOT include computer generated or photograph-altered pieces. No previously submitted pieces accepted. Any piece that includes other materials like wood or metal or paper-mâché will be considered craft and not acceptable for this competition.

**AWARDS\*\*:**

Best in Show \$500

Each Media Category: First Place \$100; Second Place \$75; Third Place \$50; and Honorable Mention Ribbons.

\*\*Please note that the judge has complete discretion in selecting the award winners and is not required to award all prizes in each Media Category.

This year's judge will be Ann Patton, a local watercolorist and resident of Bosque County. She found art as a child, and it has been a part of her life always. She earnestly took up painting as a central focus in 2014 after retiring from her career in banking. She finds inspiration in the world she lives in... birds, horses, cattle, landscapes, family and friends, or anything else that brings joy and satisfaction. As she expresses, "I love the vibrant, pure colors of watercolor and the effect of light in my paintings". She is a member of the Society of Watercolor Artists in Ft. Worth, TX. She has competed and received awards in the Bosque Arts Center's Art Classic over the past decade.

Overall size, not including matting, may not exceed 24" x 36". All pieces MUST be signed in the lower left or right corner on the front. Every piece MUST be framed and/or matted and the hanging mechanism must be able to hold the piece's weight. In the past we have experienced very poor hanging methods and capabilities. Art hanging has failed and ended up on the floor of the gallery; the Art Council is not responsible for any damages to the art due to failed hanging mechanisms. If framed with glass, a wire hanger MUST be securely attached and suitable for its weight.

More than one work may be submitted. However, due to space limitations and entries received, the Art Council will determine the number of pieces each student is allowed.

Each submission MUST be listed and titled on a separate entry form. The entry form must then be SECURELY attached to the back of the art piece. If work is to be sold, the price must be on the entry form. Work will be considered "Not for Sale" unless priced on the entry form.

Submissions MUST be delivered to the Bosque Arts Center (BAC), located at 215 S. College Hill Dr. in Clifton, between February 26 and February 28. The BAC Hours of operation are 9am - 5pm, Monday through Friday. Contact John Linn prior to February 21st if you are unable to deliver art to the Bosque Arts Center.

The Show runs for public viewing from March 4 to March 15, 2024. All artists and their family and friends are invited to a reception at the Bosque Arts Center, on Saturday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m. The awards ceremony will begin at 2:15 p.m.

Unsold work must be picked up the following week, March 18-22, after the public viewing. Sold artwork can be picked up by the purchaser at the Arts Center that same week.
