2024 College Scholarship Application

Award: The Art Council of the Bosque Arts Center will award one (1) \$1,000.00 scholarship to a graduating senior from an area high school or home school who has been accepted to attend a college, university, or technical school majoring in a visual art curriculum, i.e. painting, graphic arts, architecture, interior design, advertising art, photography, etc

Eligibility: The selected student must be a 2024 graduating senior to receive the award which will be based upon the review of the student's submitted application by the Art Council Scholarship committee. Payment shall be made directly to the college, university, or technical school where the student has been accepted and is to enroll, and can be applied to tuition, books, fees, or room/board at the discretion of the student. The student must remain enrolled for at least one full semester (or quarter) or the award must be returned to the Art Council.

Application Procedures: Recipient will be selected on the basis of combined need and merit. The central office at each high school will be asked to certify the student's grades and rankings. All decisions of the Art Council Scholarship committee are final. In the event that a scholarship is returned or not used by a successful applicant, the money can be awarded to an alternate candidate, or retained for use in future years.

Selection Criteria: To be selected, a student must:

- Have an overall high school grade average of 80 or above. Include the student's work completed through the middle of the senior year.
- Be of exemplary character & well respected in the community.
- Receive the written recommendation of two persons from their community.
- Complete the required application forms, including preparation of a short essay concerning the student's plans and goals.
- Major in a visual art-related field.
