Judge - Teal Blake, CA

Growing up in the Rocky Mountains of Montana, Teal Blake played in his father's studio and dreamed of creating his own tributes to the American West. Years spent ranching and riding in rodeos lent plenty of inspiration to guide his work; Teal credits his authenticity as a western artist to "simply being fortunate enough to work and ride alongside" his "friends and muses." He has been featured in such magazines as *Western Horseman, Western Art & Architecture, Southwest Art, Ranch & Reata,* and *The Cowboy Way.* Writer Thomas McGuane used Teal's painting *Morning Gather* for the cover of his 2013 release of *Some Horses.* Teal has garnered repeated honors in the Bosque Art Classic, including the Gold Medal Watercolor in 2014 for *Too Early for the Sun.* Other major awards include the Joe Beeler CAA Foundation Award and First Place Watercolor at the Phippen Museum. In 2014, Blake's efforts and accomplishments earned him an invitation to join the prestigious Cowboy Artists of America. He quickly thereafter proved himself in the water solubles medium at CAA shows, winning silver in 2015 and gold in 2016.

32nd Annual Bosque Art Classic Application Eligibility/Guidelines

All Categories: Drawing, Oil/Acrylic, Pastel, Sculpture, & Water Media

- Open to all artists 18 years or older
- Original, Realistic/Representational art only
- Other than submitting for the John Steven Jones Award (see below), there is no maximum or minimum number of entries.
- 2D (two-dimensional) entries must be original paintings completed from 2016 to the present.
- Older works will be disqualified. Works of art previously submitted to THIS SHOW or works completed during a workshop or under the instruction of another artist are <u>ineligible</u>. No prints (paper or giclée enhanced or otherwise), etchings, litho, airbrush, crafts, ceramics, fabrics, photographically produced or computer-generated/enhanced artwork.
- ALL 2D PIECES MUST BE FRAMED and with wire (no saw tooth hooks) ready for hanging. <u>This includes gallery</u> <u>wrapped paintings.</u> "Floater" frames must extend around the edges of the piece. Screws should be placed 1/3 of the way down from the top of frame.
- Paintings **MUST NOT EXCEED 30" on either dimension (unframed image size)**. Paintings exceeding this size will be **automatically rejected** and entry fee will **NOT** be refunded.
- All work must be for sale.

Drawing - Includes graphite pencil, charcoal, pen & ink, colored pencil, etc.

Pastel - In addition to the above guidelines, must be under glass, but the Art Council bears no responsibility for breakage of the glass at any time.

Sculpture - In addition to the above guidelines, must be completed from <u>2015 to present</u>. Images of clay may be submitted; however, final acceptance will be determined upon arrival of finished piece. All sculpture must have a <u>firmly attached base</u> and may not exceed **60 lbs**. Limited edition sculptures need not be for sale as long as orders may be taken.

Water Media - In addition to the above guidelines, water media paintings must be under plexiglass.

NOTE: We would like to encourage all artists entering the show to submit an additional smaller piece (sized 8x10 to 9x12).

John Steven Jones Purchase Award Application Eligibility/Guidelines

- Procedures above also apply to the John Steven Jones Purchase Award.
- A minimum of four (4) separate entries is required to be eligible for the John Steven Jones Award. All accepted work will be considered for the John Steven Jones Purchase Award.
- The John Steven Jones Award recipient *must* be present opening night to receive this award and will be notified prior to opening night.
- Entrant must be 18 years of age or older and a US citizen.
- Past John Steven Jones Award Winners are not eligible for the John Steven Jones Award but are eligible for all other awards.
- The John Steven Jones Award recipient will receive \$5,000 only for the purchase of one piece of artwork regardless of submitted sales price. It is *not* awarded in addition to the sales price.
- The entry form must be marked to indicate the applicant is applying for the John Steven Jones Award. If the form is not marked accordingly, it will be assumed the applicant is not applying for the John Steven Jones Award.

Note: Any piece that does not meet entry criteria will be automatically rejected, and the entry fee<u>will NOT be refunded</u>.

General Entry Information

• DEADLINE TO RECEIVE ALL ENTRIES IS MAY 22, 2017.

Entries received after this date will not be accepted or processed.

- Entry fee of \$15 per online entry; \$25 per piece entered on CD (4 entries required to be eligible for John Steven Jones Award)
- For CD entries Only Mailing Address: Bosque Art Classic, PO Box 502, Clifton, TX 76634. (This is not the address for shipping art. The US Post Office will not deliver to street address.)
- Shipping address for art upon acceptance: Bosque Art Classic, 215 S. College Hill Drive, Clifton, TX 76634. *Post Office will not deliver to street address.
- All Entries must be submitted with a completed entry form.
- Make check payable to Bosque Art Council or provide credit card number on the entry form. Online entries must be paid with a credit card. Artists outside the US: Pay by credit card only.

TitleOfPainting.jpg Image Prep: Get a quality digital image of each painting. For publicity & judging purposes, please do not submit images with copyright watermarks, logos, etc. Images should be photographed ←(1200-2400 pixels)→ without frames and unnecessary, distracting background scenes.

The longer dimension of each image should be no smaller than 1200 pixels and no larger than 2400 pixels; JPG format; RGB color mode. Sculptors may submit up to three images of each piece, which we highly encourage.

**NOTE: Please check your image carefully BEFORE submitting. Image substitutions after entering will be charged additional fees.

Image substitutions after entering will be charged additional fees. We highly discourage making online entries via smartphones because of the inability to check images for blurriness before submitting.

CD Entry Procedures

CD Entries: Follow all recommendations for images above. Label each image with the title. Include a completed entry form with your CD. Sculptors may submit up to three images of each piece. CDs will be returned only if a mailer with appropriate amount of return postage is provided. Professional quality CDs are recommended by the judges.
