Judge - Jason Rich, CA

Invited to be a member of the Cowboy Artists of America in 2011, Jason Rich had been more or less preparing for that moment all his life, with childhood summers spent on cattle drives and spare moments spent drawing horses. "Every painting starts with the horse for me," Rich says, "the way the light catches its gesture and movement." At Utah State University, Rich studied art under Glenn Edwards, a talented artist/instructor who encouraged traditional and representational art in a department that primarily emphasized the abstract and contemporary. After graduation Rich pursued art full-time. He received the Arts for the Parks Grand Prize in 1997 and Founders Favorite Award in '98. He also won Best New Auction Artist Award at the C.M. Russell Auction in '98. He was the featured cowboy artist at the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum's National Day of the American Cowboy event celebrating John Wayne's 100th birthday. He was selected as the 2014 Western Artist of the Year by the Academy of Western Artists. His Cowboy Artists of America honors include winning the Silver Medal Oil in the 2012 and 2013 shows and the 2012 TCAA Award for Best Portrayal of a Cowboy Subject, as well as being voted the Stetson Award by active CAA members for best overall exhibition at the 2015 CAA Exhibition and Sale.

33rd Annual Bosque Art Classic Application Eligibility/Guidelines

All Categories: Drawing, Oil/Acrylic, Pastel, Sculpture, & Water Media

- Open to all artists 18 years or older
- Original, Realistic/Representational art only

- **Note: Any piece that does not meet entry criteria will be automatically rejected, and the entry fee will NOT be refunded.**
- Other than submitting for the John Steven Jones Award (see below), there is no maximum or minimum number of entries.
- **2D** (two-dimensional) entries must be original paintings completed from **2017 to the present**.
- Older works will be disqualified. Works of art previously submitted to THIS SHOW or works completed during a workshop or under the instruction of another artist are <u>ineligible</u>. No prints (paper or giclée enhanced or otherwise), etchings, litho, airbrush, crafts, ceramics, fabrics, photographically produced or computer-generated/enhanced artwork.
- ALL 2D PIECES MUST BE FRAMED and with wire (no saw tooth hooks) ready for hanging. This includes gallery wrapped paintings. "Floater" frames must extend around the edges of the piece. Screws should be placed 1/3 of the way down from the top of frame.
- Paintings **MUST NOT EXCEED 30" on either dimension (unframed image size)**. Paintings exceeding this size will be **automatically rejected** and entry fee will **NOT** be refunded.
- · All work must be for sale.

Drawing - Includes graphite pencil, charcoal, pen & ink, colored pencil, etc.

Pastel - In addition to the above guidelines, must be under glass, but the Art Council bears no responsibility for breakage of the glass at any time.

Sculpture - In addition to the above guidelines, must be completed from **2016 to present**. Images of clay may be submitted; however, final acceptance will be determined upon arrival of finished piece. All sculpture must have a **firmly attached base** and may not exceed **60 lbs**. Limited edition sculptures need not be for sale as long as orders may be taken.

Water Media - In addition to the above guidelines, water media paintings must be under plexiglass.

NOTE: We would like to encourage all artists entering the show to submit an additional smaller piece (sized 8x10 to 9x12).

John Steven Jones Purchase Award Application Eligibility/Guidelines

- Procedures above also apply to the John Steven Jones Purchase Award.
- A minimum of four (4) separate entries is required to be eligible for the John Steven Jones Award. All accepted work will be considered for the John Steven Jones Purchase Award.
- The John Steven Jones Award recipient <u>must</u> be present opening night to receive this award and will be notified prior to opening night.
- Entrant must be 18 years of age or older and a US citizen.
- Past John Steven Jones Award Winners are not eligible for the John Steven Jones Award but are eligible for all other awards.
- The John Steven Jones Award recipient will receive \$5,000 only for the purchase of one piece of artwork regardless of submitted sales price. It is *not* awarded in addition to the sales price.
- The entry form must be marked to indicate the applicant is applying for the John Steven Jones Award. If the form is not marked
 accordingly, it will be assumed the applicant is not applying for the John Steven Jones Award.

General Entry Information

- DEADLINE TO RECEIVE ALL ENTRIES IS MAY 29, 2018.
 - Online entries close at 11:59 p.m. CDT on May 29. Entries received after this date will not be accepted or processed.
- Entry fee of \$15 per online entry; \$25 per piece entered on CD (4 entries required to be eligible for John Steven Jones Award)
- For CD entries Only Mailing Address: Bosque Art Classic, PO Box 502, Clifton, TX 76634. (This is <u>not</u> the address for shipping art. *The US Post Office will not deliver to street address.*)
- Shipping address for art upon acceptance: Bosque Art Classic, 215 S. College Hill Drive, Clifton, TX 76634. *Post Office will not deliver to street address.
- All entries must be submitted with a completed entry form (online or mailed).
- Make check payable to Bosque Art Council or provide credit card number on the entry form. *Online entries must be paid with a credit card.* Artists outside the US: Pay by credit card only.

Digital Image Entry Criteria

Image Prep: Get a quality digital image of each painting. For publicity & judging purposes, please do not submit images with copyright watermarks, logos, etc. Images should be photographed without frames and unnecessary, distracting background scenes.

The longer dimension of each image should be **no smaller than 1200 pixels** and **no larger than 2400 pixels**; JPG format; RGB color mode. **Sculptors must submit** <u>three (3) images</u> of each piece.

Online Entries: Follow all recommendations for images above. Go to www.BosqueArtsCenter.org and look for the Bosque Art Classic link under Events or on our home page (or type in https://www.bosqueartscenter.org/page/artclassic.aspx). If you did not create a user ID last year, you will need to create one. (ID's are based on your email address.) Once entries are being accepted, a link to the online entry form will appear on that page. Follow all on-screen instructions and have your credit card ready for payment of entry fees. We highly discourage making online entries via smartphones because of the inability to check images for blurriness before submitting.

CD Entry Procedures

CD Entries: Follow all recommendations for images above. **Label each image with the title**. Include a completed entry form with your CD. Sculptors *must* submit three images of each piece. CDs will be returned only if a mailer with appropriate amount of return postage is provided. Professional quality CDs are recommended by the judges.

No price changes are permitted <u>after</u> acceptance into the show. Be sure to build into your price the 25% commission along with shipping charges you expect to incur.

The BAC Art Council reserves the right to authenticate all pieces submitted to the Bosque Art Classic. We reserve the right of acceptance or refusal of your work upon arrival. If the work is not acceptable, you will be notified and the work returned immediately.

SHIPPING NOTES

Work shipped using packing peanuts will not be accepted into the show.

Artwork will be returned in the same container in which it is received.

*DO <u>NOT</u> USE THE U.S. POSTAL SERVICE TO SHIP ACTUAL ARTWORK
