2023 Judge - Seth Hopkins

Seth Hopkins was the Booth Western Art Museum's first employee, hired as executive director in 2000. Since then he has guided the museum in Cartersville, Georgia, to becoming a world class, 120,000-square-foot Smithsonian-Affiliated museum. Today, the Booth is the largest permanent exhibition space for Western art in the country and has been named the #1 Art Museum in America in the USA Today Readers Choice Awards for three years in a row, from 2020 to 2022.

Hopkins earned his undergraduate degree from Syracuse University and received his masters from Oklahoma University under the tutelage of legendary Western art historian Byron Price. His master's thesis, *Andy Warhol Played Cowboys and Indians*, became a national traveling art exhibition in 2019, making stops at The Eiteljorg in Indianapolis, The National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum in Oklahoma City, and The James in St. Petersburg, FL. All together, he has curated or co-curated almost 100 art exhibitions. Hopkins has published articles in *American Art Review, Western Art Collector, Western Art and Architecture, Art of the West,* and *Persimmon Hill.* In 2010 he received the Flourish Award, given annually to a leader who has helped the arts flourish in Georgia. In addition, *Southwest Art Magazine* included Hopkins on its list of 10 prominent people who are "making noteworthy contributions to the art world."

38th Annual Bosque Art Classic Application Eligibility/Guidelines

All Categories: Drawing, Oil/Acrylic, Pastel, Sculpture, & Water Media

- Open to all artists 18 years or older
- Original, Realistic/Representational art only

- **Note: Any piece that does not meet entry criteria will be automatically rejected, and the entry fee <u>will NOT be refunded</u>.**
- Other than submitting for the John Steven Jones Award (see below), there is no maximum or minimum number of entries.
- 2D (two-dimensional) entries must be original paintings completed from 2022 to the present.
- Older works will be disqualified. Works of art previously submitted to THIS SHOW, works completed during a workshop or under the instruction of another artist, or works based on other copyrighted artwork/photography are <u>ineligible</u>. No prints (paper or giclée - enhanced or otherwise), etchings, litho, airbrush, crafts, ceramics, fabrics, photographically produced or computer-generated/ enhanced artwork will be accepted.
- ALL 2D PIECES MUST BE FRAMED and with wire (no sawtooth hooks) ready for hanging. <u>This includes gallery wrapped</u> <u>paintings.</u> "Floater" frames must extend around the edges of the piece. Screws should be placed 1/3 of the way down from the top of frame.
- Paintings **MUST NOT EXCEED 30**" on either dimension (unframed image size). Paintings exceeding this size will be automatically rejected and entry fee will **NOT** be refunded.
- All work must be for sale.

INDIVIDUAL CATEGORY NOTES (in addition to the above guidelines):

Drawing - Includes graphite pencil, charcoal, pen & ink, colored pencil, etc.

Pastel - Must be under glass, but the Art Council bears no responsibility for breakage of the glass at any time.

Sculpture - Must be completed from <u>2021 to present</u>. Images of clay may be submitted; however, final acceptance will be determined upon arrival of finished piece. All sculpture may not exceed **60 lbs**. Limited edition sculptures need not be for sale as long as orders may be taken.

Water Media - Water media paintings must be under plexiglass and painted on at least 300# watercolor paper.

NOTE: We would like to encourage all artists entering the show to submit an additional smaller piece (sized 8x10 to 9x12).

John Steven Jones Purchase Award Application Eligibility/Guidelines

- Procedures above also apply to the John Steven Jones Purchase Award.
- A minimum of four (4) separate entries is required to be eligible for the John Steven Jones Award. All accepted work will be considered for the John Steven Jones Purchase Award.
- The John Steven Jones Award recipient <u>must</u> be present opening night to receive this award and will be notified prior to opening night.
- Entrant must be 18 years of age or older and a US citizen.
- Past John Steven Jones Award Winners are not eligible for the John Steven Jones Award but are eligible for all other awards.
- The John Steven Jones Award recipient will receive \$5,000 only for the purchase of one piece of artwork regardless of submitted sales price. It is *not* awarded in addition to the sales price.
- The entry form must be marked to indicate the applicant is applying for the John Steven Jones Award. If the form is not marked accordingly, it will be assumed the applicant is not applying for the John Steven Jones Award.

General Entry Information

- **DEADLINE TO** <u>**RECEIVE</u> ALL ENTRIES IS** <u>**MAY 31, 2023.**</u> (This includes mailed entries.) Online entries close <u>at 11:59 p.m. CDT</u> on May 31. Entries received after this date will not be accepted or processed.</u>
- Entry fee of \$25 per online entry; \$30 per piece entered on CD (4 entries required to be eligible for John Steven Jones Award)

Digital Image Entry Criteria

Image Prep: Get a quality digital image of each painting. For publicity & judging purposes, please do not submit images with copyright watermarks, logos, etc. Images should be photographed without frames and unnecessary, distracting background scenes. The longer dimension of each image should be **no smaller than 1200 pixels** and **no larger** (longer side)

The longer dimension of each image should be **no smaller than 1200 pixels** and **no larger than 2400 pixels**; JPG format; RGB color mode. **Sculptors must submit** <u>three (3) images</u> of **each piece**.

**NOTE: <u>Please check your image carefully</u> BEFORE submitting and be sure it is your <u>final version</u> of the artwork. Image substitutions after the deadline may be charged additional fees and/or the <u>entry may be rejected</u> <u>altogether if substantial changes to the art are apparent.</u>

Online Entries: Follow all recommendations for images above. Go to www.BosqueArtsCenter.org and look for the Bosque Art Classic link under Events or on our home page (or type in https://www.bosqueartscenter.org/page/artclassic.aspx). **If you did not create a user ID in 2017 or later, you will need to create one.** (ID's are based on your email address.) Once entries are being accepted, a link to the <u>online entry form</u> will appear on that page. Follow all on-screen instructions and have your credit card ready for payment of entry fees. We highly discourage making online entries via smartphones because of the inability *to check images for blurriness before submitting*. **NOTE: Please verify your address is correct in your account profile and update it if not current** before making entries. (Updating your address at the payment stage *will not* update it in the profile.)

CD Entry Procedures

CD Entries: Follow all recommendations for images above. **Label each image with the title**. Include a completed entry form with your CD. Sculptors *must* submit three images of each piece. CDs will be returned only if a mailer with appropriate amount of return postage is provided. Professional quality CDs are recommended by the judges.

Work shipped using packing peanuts <u>will not be accepted</u> into the show.

Artwork will be returned in the same container in which it is received.

*DO <u>NOT</u> USE THE U.S. POSTAL SERVICE TO SHIP ACTUAL ARTWORK OR YOUR WORK <u>WILL BE REJECTED AND RETURNED</u> TO YOU. They do not deliver art to our building. Use UPS, FedEx, Lone Star, or similar carriers.

While your work is on the Arts Center's premises, it will be insured at the sales price you have provided. The Bosque Arts Center and BAC Art Council assume no responsibility for damage in shipping; each artist is responsible for obtaining appropriate insurance for artwork
