

Are you ready to take pencil and graphite drawing to the next level?

Brenda Murphy, known for her highly realistic and sensitively rendered "pencil paintings," will be conducting a two-day workshop on February 8-9. The focus will be the techniques she uses to create realistic finished drawings.

Brenda will conduct a demo and discuss composition, light, edges, value, and the importance of good contrast in graphite drawings. Students will be supplied photo reference and a variety of started drawings to choose from, which they will then work on directly. There will be lots of emphasis on textures, layering, and how to achieve depth with graphite. There will be less emphasis on the drawing process and more emphasis on technique.

She's a multi-award-winning artist who achieved a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from the University of Texas at Arlington and then worked in Dallas as a graphic designer and illustrator. From this foundation, she moved on to establish a career in fine art, exhibiting in top galleries such as Trailside Galleries, Settlers West Gallery, and Texas Art Gallery. Brenda has received numerous awards for her artwork including the following: the 2003 Patron's Purchase Award at the Bosque Art Classic in Clifton, Texas; the 2005 Patron's Choice Award at the Western Visions show at the National Museum of Wildlife Art in Jackson, Wyoming; the 2006 Museum Purchase Award at the Desert Caballeros Museum's Cowgirl Up! Show in Wickenburg, Arizona; and the 2008 Patron's Choice Award at the National Cowgirl Museum's Heart of the West Art Show and Auction in Fort Worth, Texas. She

has been featured in major publications such as Art of the West, Southwest Art and Western Horseman magazines. She is represented by Trailside Galleries in Jackson, Wyoming and also by Settlers West Gallery in Tucson, Arizona.

Born and raised in Texas, Brenda fosters a close relationship with her models that provide inspiration, resources, and a valued critical eye to insure authenticity in her work. She and her husband, Tom, reside in Arlington, Texas, where she maintains a studio in her home.
