



REQUIREMENTS

CONTEST ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Each entry **MUST** have a label attached to the back of the quilt (preferably the bottom back LEFT corner). Label must contain: a) quilt name; b) name of person submitting; c) address & phone number. **LABEL MUST BE COVERED UPON ARRIVAL!**
2. Each entry **MUST** have a 4" sleeve for hanging. Extra-large quilts must have a sleeve approximately 85" from the bottom of the quilt. Quilts received without a sleeve will be rejected and entry fee will be forfeited.
3. False back quilts will not be accepted for judging.
4. Quilt must be delivered and received in a pillowcase (or cloth bag) with the NAME OF QUILT, ENTRANT'S NAME, ADDRESS, and PHONE NUMBER written on or firmly attached **TO THE OUTSIDE OF THE PILLOWCASE.**
5. You must provide an entry form for each quilt. With EACH ENTRY FORM you are required to provide two (2) full color 4"x6" photos of the quilt. Place your name, address, phone number, email address and quilt name on the back of each photo. One photo becomes the property of the Bosque Arts Center.
6. The quilt top must be made by the person submitting the entry for judging.
7. If display room permits, heirloom quilts may be displayed but are not eligible for competition. A non-refundable \$5 fee for display only.
8. Bosque Arts Center has the exclusive right to reclassify any quilt based on the judges' discretion.

CATEGORIES

- E – Machine pieced; LAQ, hand guided
Small (25" to 59" on any one side)
- F – Machine pieced; LAQ, hand guided
Medium (60" to 89" on any one side)
- G – Machine pieced; LAQ, hand guided
Large (90" or more on any one side)
- H – Machine pieced: LAQ, computerized
Small (25" to 59" on any one side)
- J – Machine pieced: LAQ, computerized
Medium (60" to 89" on any one side)
- K – Machine pieced; LAQ, computerized
Large (90" or more on any one side)
- L – Applique: by hand
- M – Applique: by machine
- N – Miniature (a quilt in which the pattern is of a larger quilt but every element has been reduced to scale. **No more than 24" on any side.**)
- O – Modern (a quilt incorporating these items, bold use of color, negative layout, asymmetry, free form construction, unique fabric combinations, abstract design, contemporary themes, reinterpretation of traditional designs, or improvisational piecing)
- P – Art Quilts
- Q – Holiday Quilts (any recognized holiday)
- S – Home Décor and Wall Hangings
- T – Group Quilts (3 or more people involved in piecing, applique or embroidery)
- U – Other Techniques – Crazy Quilts, Yo-Yos, fused dimensional, etc. which cannot be placed in another category
- V – Wearables – clothes, bags, scarves, vests, jackets, etc.
- W – Junior Quilts – Youth 18 years of age or younger
- X – Baby Quilts – Use for babies and small children, approximately 37" x 52" in size for use with crib or baby size batting at 45" x 60".
- Y – Whole Cloth – Top made of one solid piece of fabric, focusing on displaying the makers hand, needlework, or machine skills.
