I use Michael Harding and Winsor & Newton Professional grade paints but we can work with what you already have. If you are purchasing burnt umber, please try to get W&N or M Harding burnt umber. I will have all these colors out on my palette but "Convenience colors" are NOT required. No need to purchase colors you may never use again.

Brushes:

- 1. For smooth surfaces (masonite panels): # 8 & 10 synthetic (I like filberts but use what you have). Size #'s have changed so they're about 1/4" and 3/8" wide ...larger is okay.
- 2. For Canvas stretched or panels: # 8 & 10 bristle flat or filberts
- 3. Smaller detail brush ...#2 flat or filbert
- 4. Small painting knife (if you already have one)
- 5. Please don't go buy supplies you may never use again! I try to work with what you already have.

Large palette (I use 12x16 Richeson Grey Matters palette paper) ...no paper plates please.

Gamsol (or other artist odorless thinner). Container/jar

Viva paper towels (or similar absorbent paper towels)

Liquin (or other medium) ... I use VERY little medium but I like to have it on hand

Easel

4 or 5 boards/canvases: Sizes 12x16 or 11x14. Better to have too many than not enough.
