Call for Entries February 10

Requirements:

- The show is open to Drawings, Oil/Acrylic, Pastel, and Water Media produced within the last two (2) years. Photography is not accepted.
- The predominant subject matter of artwork must contain some type of flower.
- Each artist may submit no more than two pieces of art that have not been previously shown in Bosque County.
- The artwork must be based on the artists' original ideas, sketches, or personal photos. No prints, giclées, electronic or photographically produced artwork will be accepted.
- Submitted work must not exceed 24"x 24" image size. All artwork requires a wire hanger for hanging. Gallery wrapped canvas is accepted without frame.
- The Bosque Arts Center requires art to be hand delivered by the Artist or representative on April 10th or 11th. Entry forms will be completed by the artist at that time.
- All entries must be for sale. Artists will price their entries. The Bosque Arts Center will receive a 25% commission for all work that is sold during the show.
- To be eligible for judging, non-refundable entry fees (\$25 for 1st piece, \$20 for 2nd) must be paid at time of entry. Cash, check or credit cards accepted. Checks payable to Bosque Arts Center.
- This is a juried show, and as such, not all submissions will be displayed. The Arts Center reserves the right to not hang any artwork that does not comply with all of the above rules and requirements. If an art piece does not pass the jury or does not comply with the rules, you will be notified via email by April 18.

Following the submitted works' judging by distinguished judge Cheryle Chapline, the show opens to the public on Saturday, April 26th 6 - 8p with a Reception and Awards Ceremony. Cash prizes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Popular Choice will be awarded. The show continues Monday - Friday April 28 - May 9, 10a - 5p and Sunday, May 4th 1 - 5p on the second floor of the Bosque Arts Center. The Bosque County Art Club invites artists, those who love art, and those who appreciate the beauty of flowers (Isn't that everyone?) to enjoy this creative and colorful show. ABOUT THE JUDGE, CHERYLE CHAPLINE

The resonating theme throughout the life of fine artist Cheryle Chapline is one of visual discovery. By observing the common-place and transforming her interpretation of the subject into fine art, Ms. Chapline has built a lasting legacy of work that changes the viewers' perspective. The observer sees the subject, literally, in a whole new perspective because of the interplay of light and color which is accomplished with glazing the underpainting prior to the application of local color. Watercolor, as her primary medium, lends itself to this method of color theory by capitalizing on its transparent qualities, allowing color to mix optically on the paper rather than color mixing on the palette. A visual vibration is created that can not be created in any other way, drawing attention to the vast variety of hues and tones present in our natural world.

Ms. Chapline has a degree in Fine Art from Florida State University and consistently pursues new horizons as a life-long learner. Ms. Chapline began her early career as a graphic designer and art director, eventually owning a graphic design and print-brokering business, all the while creating her fine art. In addition to producing her award-winning paintings, she taught digital imaging, photography and graphic design at the college level. She has been passionately teaching fine art classes for adults since 2000 and is a frequent presenter and juror/judge for watercolor and fine art groups. Her professional affiliations include American Watercolor Society, National Watercolor Society, Southwestern Watercolor Society, Watercolor Society of South Texas and Central Texas Watercolor Society.

Ms. Chapline has been published in four *Splash*, *The Best in Watercolor* international competition publications, including last years *Splash 25*. Her work has been included in the *National Watercolor Society's 97th International Exhibition* as well as the *Louisiana Watercolor Society's International Exhibition '23*, with Carrie Waller serving as juror/judge. Ms. Chapline's paintings have also been included in several *Richeson 75 International figure/portrait* competition books, in the *Art of Watercolour* magazine as one of fifteen Reader's Choice awards, as well as being represented in an exhibition for the *Hunting Art Prize*.
